

Customer Release Notes - Release 06.00

Product:

Print File Downloader for Windows (Win PFD)

New Items:

- This release supports *Danish, Dutch, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Norwegian, Portuguese, Spanish and Swedish*, for those brands that support these languages.
- The Job Setup> Page Features tabbed window has been redesigned to make the setup of multiple subsets, quicker and easier. (PR#38766)
- Information in Help has been updated.
- The software now creates a "System defaults.dsf" that is equal to factory default settings at startup, if the file doesn't already exist. The filename for default settings has been changed from "Default" to "System defaults". (#38596/#39946)
- Unique PPDs are no longer distributed with the Win PFD starting with Release 6.0. The standard PPDs are now compatible with the Win PFD.
- The Win PFD now recognizes and displays the paper attributes for punching and precollated media in the paper catalog.

Known Problems, Limitations and Workarounds in This Release:

- When choosing Select All Pages, and then creating an Exception as Print Side 1 or 2, or Job Settings, the Win PFD will create a false constraint. To work around this, set Sides to Job Settings, and then set Printed Sides to Job Settings. (#32322)
- On a Japanese system, it is recommended that full-width numeric characters not be entered in numeric fields on the Win PFD user interface. Even though these characters are not rejected, they are invalid and an "invalid value entered" error message will be displayed. (#38427)
- The Win PFD allows the selection of a subset with valid paper combinations to different finishing devices. However, this paper combination is not supported by the system and will result in a mismatch. (#38112)

- It is recommended to use the Paper Catalog Utility (PCU) to edit the Paper Catalog. The Paper Catalog Utility (PCU) must be installed separately. The Win PFD standard installation does not include the installation of the PCU.
- When the English version of the PFD is uninstalled and another language is installed that does not contain "letter" in the catalog, then a dialog is presented every time the PFD is started saying there is an unknown paper substitution. The problem occurs because the system default file is not removed when the software is uninstalled. When English is installed, the system defaults are created and "letter" is the default for body media, which does not exist in the paper catalogs for the other languages. The problem will keep recurring every time the PFD is started. To avoid this problem, replace the System Default settings with new settings by selecting Save As from the Templates tabbed page. For the filename enter "System defaults.dsf". Alternately, you can remove System defaults.dsf before installing the language version of the PFD. (#40124)

Previous Release Problems That Have Been Fixed:

- For jobs that are directed to go to the Booklet Maker or Other Finisher, if an insert was requested to go to the same exit as the job, i.e. Job Settings, would result in a potential mismatch for the insert pages. (#37351)
- The Reorder Last Sheet setting is not correctly saved or restored in driver settings files. (#38974/#39725)
- The Summary screen does not always accurately reflect all PDF Options. (#38973)
- The Win PFD will support only one language installation at a time. If an attempt is made to install another language, the installer program will prompt to uninstall the current software. (#38253)
- Custom options behaves differently than release 5 PFD, inserting an extra carriage return line feed after the custom option file, when Custom Options only is selected. This may result in font downloading not working. (#39845)
- Some papers may be selected to be punched within the Win PFD, but the Puncher will invoke a limit for paper sizes that are not supported. (#29386)
- The Win PFD will crash when trying to enter a page range from 1 to -1 (From, To fields) on the Page features Tab from Microsoft Word or Microsoft WordPad applications. (#35573)
- If all continuous pages are selected for 2-Sided output, and one page within those continuous pages is selected to Force Side 2, all pages will print 2-Sided and the Force Side 2 is ignored.

- On systems where the PFD/PS Print Driver (PSD) has been installed and not run at least once, opening the Desktop icon will cause the PCU to display an error message.
